

ADMINISTRATIVE ORDER OF COURT

AND NOW, this 20<sup>th</sup> day of December, 2022, in consideration of the recent increase in permitted maximum monthly guardianship fees in Medicaid cases from \$100.00 per month to \$300.00 per month effective January 1, 2023, it is hereby **ORDERED** and **DECREED** that, effective January 1, 2023, all currently serving Jefferson County court-appointed professional guardians who had previously been court authorized to receive monthly monetary compensation (e.g. \$100 per month) from Medicaid in Jefferson County guardianship cases, are now authorized to receive \$300.00 per month from Medicaid in those cases, without the need to file a petition seeking that fee increase. The Jefferson County Court Administrator shall post notice of this order on the Jefferson County Court of Common Pleas website as soon as reasonably possible and send copies of this order to all known professional/corporate court-appointed guardians.
